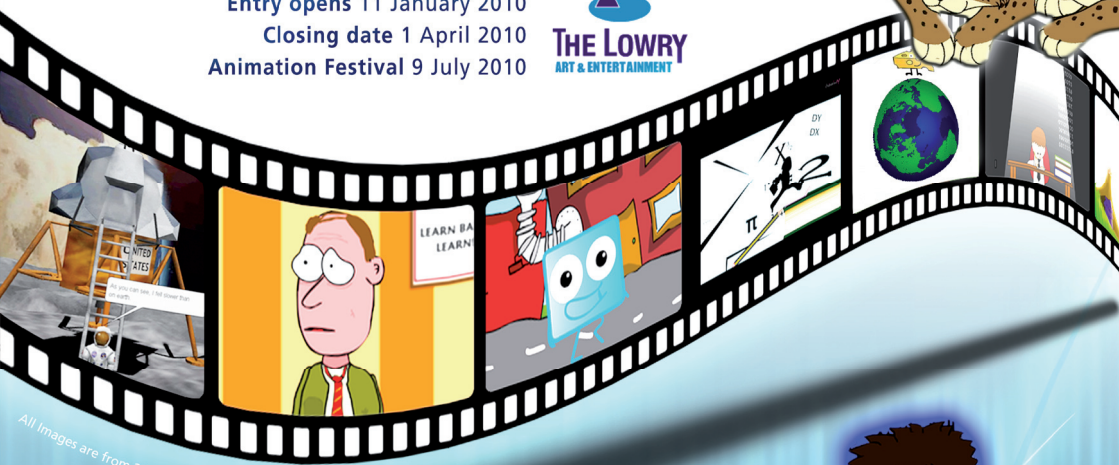

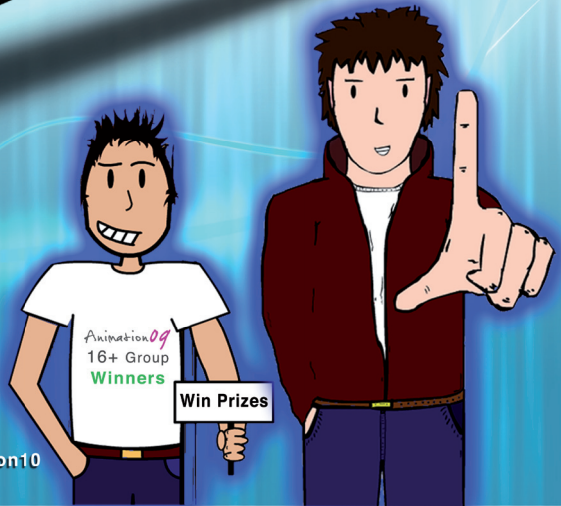

- **Flash** – Adobe’s commercial product for designing interactive multimedia and animations.
- **Greenfoot** – a Java-based programming environment for novice programmers. It’s freely available from the University of Kent.
- **Scratch** – a free downloadable programming language ideal for creation of interactive stories and art.
- **Serif DrawPlus** – a commercial drawing and animation program from Serif Ltd.

Winners will receive great prizes. Finalists will also be invited to join us for the Animation Festival and Prize Giving Day on 9 July 2010 at The Lowry.
